WHAT IS RESTORATIVE CONFERENCING?

Restorative conferencing is considered a Tier 2 or Tier 3 intervention and can be practiced at any grade level. This strategy is extremely effective in preserving relationships and ensuring every voice is heard.

Restorative conferencing is a powerful strategy to repair harm, increase empathy, and encourage understanding.

WHY RESTORATIVE CONFERENCING?

BENEFITS OF RESTORATIVE CONFERENCING INCLUDE:

- Seen as a fair and balanced process, as everyone involved in the incident has an opportunity to be heard.
- Risk of repeated incidents is reduced.
- **Repairs relationships** by acknowledging that harm was done, those involved understand the effects of their actions and reactions on others.
- **Conferencing is structured**, and those involved know what to expect of any/all sessions.¹

WHO CAN BE TRAINED?

Any educator interested in learning more about and/or facilitating restorative conferencing at the Tier 2 & 3 levels including, but not limited to, **administrators**, school counselors, specialist teachers, or others with dedicated time for interventions.
